### THE CAUSATIVE FORM

There are two major patterns used to form causative constructions in English:

#### 1- HAVE SOMETHING DONE

1. Subject	Auxiliary	Direct Object	Past Participle	(+ by+ Indirect Obj.)
A. He	will have	his car	repaired	by the mechanic.
B. He	Will get	his car	repaired	by the mechanic.

#### 2- HAVE SOMEBODY DO SOMETHING

2. Subject	Auxiliary	Indirect object	(to) infinitive	Direct Object
A. He	Will have	The mechanic	Repair	his car.
B. He	Will have	The mechanic	To repair	His car.

These two patterns can be stated in the following formulas:

- I. A. have something done by somebody
  - B. get something done by somebody
- II. A. Have somebody do something
  - B. get somebody to do something

#### \*But the direct object can be human as well as a non-human:

He had his wife killed.

She will have <u>her daughter</u> examined by the doctor.
